MINUTES

Motion by Keith Olsen to approve the minutes of April 13, 2015. Seconded by Steve Roberts. Motion carried.

RESERVE CITY CANDIDATES

Reserve City Mayoral candidates Janice Sanders and Brandon Ruch were present for the coin toss tie-breaker for the April 7, 2015 City Election. The tie-breaker was required due to the candidates each receiving 13 votes in the election.

Warren Ploeger flipped the coin, the incumbent Janice Sanders called heads. The coin was tails meaning that Ruch won the tie-breaker and therefore won the position of Reserve City Mayor.
