

NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

Brown County, Kansas will take sealed proposals for the construction of one 95'-0 long by 26'-6 wide roadway bridge including materials, labor, equipment, tools, along with appurtenances and accessories for the "Hiawatha Southeast Bridge Replacement Project." The bids will be received by the Brown County Clerk, Melissa Gormley, in her office at the Brown County Courthouse, until 4:30 pm am local time, on the nineteenth (19th) day of October, 2018, and the bids will be opened and publicly read on the twenty-second (22nd) day of October, 2018, at 9:00 am, at the Brown County Commissioner's meeting room, Brown County Courthouse, 601 Oregon Street, Hiawatha, KS 66434. Proposals will be taken for the construction work listed above by unit process, as an aggregate bid for the entire project.

The bridge crosses Wolf River and is located 3.5 miles south and 2.2 miles east of Hiawatha, KS. The bridge is on 200th Street and is 0.2 mile east of Mulberry Road. Southwest Quarter of Section 11 Township 3 South Range 17 East
