

SHALL THE FOLLOWING BE ADOPTED?

SHALL BROWN COUNTY, KANSAS, BE AUTHORIZED TO IMPOSE A ONE-HALF PERCENT (0.50%) RETAILERS' SALES TAX (THE "SALES TAX") FOR THE PURPOSE OF FINANCING THE PROVISION OF HEALTH CARE SERVICES IN THE COUNTY BY HIAWATHA COMMUNITY HOSPITAL, OR ITS SUCCESSORS, AND BY AN ENTITY PROVIDING HEALTH CARE SERVICES IN THE CITY OF HORTON, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, HOSPITAL EXPENSES AND ANY PAYMENTS WITH RESPECT TO BONDS ISSUED FOR HOSPITAL AND HEALTH CARE PURPOSES, COLLECTION OF SUCH SALES TAX TO COMMENCE ON OCTOBER 1, 2019, AND EXPIRE TEN YEARS AFTER ITS COMMENCEMENT; ALL PURSUANT TO K.S.A. 12-187 *ET SEQ.*, AS AMENDED?
